

Applications for funding must be for a purpose which furthers the aims of the Foundation which are to:

- 1. Educate people about the applied arts;
- 2. Educate further educational and teaching opportunities for art students, existing applied arts practitioners and the public and, in particular, school children and tertiary students;
- 3. Create opportunities for people to participate in the applied arts;
- Collect, maintain, curate and display applied art works particularly those by New Zealanders and develop and maintain a permanent facility for that purpose;
- 5. Such other charitable purposes as the Trustees may decide, which advance the applied arts in New Zealand.

There are three funding rounds. The deadlines are

- · 31 March,
- · 31 July and
- · 30 November.

Decisions will be made within one month of the closing date of each round.

The Foundation will assist, through funding assistance, with projects that have a clear focus and a clear outcome. What we look for in an application for funding are:

- 1. How the proposal furthers any of the Foundation's purposes;
- 2. The timeframe;
- 3. The costs and the amount being requested;
- 4. The intended audience;
- 5. A clear description of the final outcome of the proposal.
